An Act to vest a parcel of land situate at the Old Fish Market Site, Bay Street, in the parish of Saint Michael in the Crown.

(26th March, 2009). Commence-
ment.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Barbados as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the *Bay Street (Vesting) Act, 2009*. Short title.
2. From the date of the commencement of this Act all that land described in the *Schedule* including any estate, right, title or interest in, to or over that land shall, by virtue of this Act, be vested in the Crown. Vesting of land in the Crown. Schedule.

SCHEDULE

(Section 2)

ALL THAT land situate at Bay Street in the parish of Saint Michael in this Island containing by admeasurement 1984.4 square metres or thereabouts (inclusive of 1409.4 square metres of accreted land) abutting and bounding on lands now or late of Christopher Codrington on the beach on lands of the Barbados Government and on a road called Bay Street that leads to the Garrison in one direction and to Bridgetown in the other direction or however else the same may abut and bound as shown and delineated on a plan certified on the 15th day of July, 2005 by Andrew R. Bourne, Land Surveyor and recorded in the Lands and Surveys Department as Plan No. -899/2005.
