**TRAFFIC CONTROL (FORE-DAY MORNING JUMP-UP)
RULES, 2011**

The Commissioner, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 23(2) of the *Police Act*, with the approval of the Minister, makes the following Rules:

1. These Rules may be cited as the *Traffic Control (Fore-Day Morning Jump-Up) Rules, 2011*.

2. In these Rules,

“emergency vehicle” means a vehicle used by

- (a) the Barbados Red Cross;
- (b) the Department of Emergency Management; or
- (c) an ambulance service;

"relevant date" means Saturday, 30th July, 2011;

“relevant period” means from 01:30 hours to 06:00 hours;

“route” means Hincks Street, the Princess Alice Highway, Harbour Road, turning left at Holborn Circle and continuing onto the Spring Garden Highway in the parish of Saint Michael;

“vehicle” has the meaning assigned to it by section 2 of the *Road Traffic Act* Cap. 295.

3. On the relevant date, during the relevant period, a Fore-Day Morning Jump-Up will take place commencing at the Carlisle Car Park in the parish of Saint Michael and will proceed along the route.

4. On the relevant date, during the relevant period, the Spring Garden Highway from its junction with Holborn Circle to its junction with Brighton Road, in the parish of Saint Michael, shall be closed to all vehicular traffic, except vehicles used by the members of the Crop Over Festival Committee of the Ministry responsible for Family, Culture, Sports and Youth.

5. On the relevant date, during the relevant period, no person shall park or allow a vehicle to remain stationary on any of the following roads, except for the purpose of picking up or setting down passengers:

- (a) Brighton Road from its junction with Black Rock Main Road to its junction with the Spring Garden Highway;
- (b) Black Rock Main Road from its junction with University Drive to its junction with Eagle Hall Road;
- (c) Deacons Farm Road from its junction with Deacons Road to its junction with Brighton Road;
- (d) Deacons Road; or
- (e) Westbury Road,

in the parish of Saint Michael.

6. On the relevant date, during the relevant period, Brighton Road from its junction with the Spring Garden Highway to its junction with Black Rock Main Road, shall be a one-way street with vehicles travelling in the direction of Black Rock Main Road.

7. All drivers and riders of vehicles, pedestrians and riders or leaders of animals using any of the roads specified in paragraphs 4, 5 and 6 shall exercise caution and shall comply with any order given by a member of the Police Force in uniform.

8. Any person who contravenes these Rules or fails to comply with any order given by a member of the Police Force in uniform is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500 or to imprisonment for a term of 3 months.

9. These Rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Police Force, the Barbados Defence Force, the Barbados Fire Service or any emergency vehicle.
