HIGHWAYS (ABANDONMENT) NOTICE, 2014

The Minister, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 11 of the *Highways Act*, gives the following Notice:

Citation

1. This Notice may be cited as the *Highways (Abandonment) Notice, 2014*.
2. The roads described in the Schedule to this Notice are to be abandoned.
3. The rights of the public in respect of the public roads, referred to in the Schedule, are to be abandoned as these roads are to be used to facilitate the construction of a roundabout at the intersection of the Speightstown By-Pass Road with Archer's Lane and Little Battaley's Road, in the parish of Saint Peter.
4. The public may object to the matter contained in this Notice, and any such objection shall contain the grounds of objection and shall reach the Minister not later than the 28th day of February, 2014.

SCHEDULE*(Paragraphs 2 and 3)**Roads to be abandoned*

ALL THAT land situate at Queen's Street in the parish of Saint Peter containing approximately 768.6 square metres or thereabouts, abutting and bounding to the north on a public road known as Highway 1 to the east on lands of Easylin Inc. to the south, on a public road known as the Speightstown By-Pass Road and to the west on lands of Easylin Inc. or however else the same may abut and bound.

ALL THAT land situate at Archer's Lane in the parish of Saint Peter containing approximately 240 square metres or thereabouts, abutting and bounding to the north, on lands of the Estate of Michael Belle, to the east on a public road known as Archer's Lane, to the south on lands of Easylin Inc. and to the west on a public road known as Queen's Street or however else the same may abut and bound.
