CHAPTER 93C

DEVELOPMENT (CANADIAN LOAN) (LAND MAPPING AND REGISTRY)

An Act to authorise the Government to borrow from the Government of Canada for the purposes specified in this Act an amount of money not exceeding the amount so specified and for related purposes.

[29th April, 1982.] Commencement.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Development (Canadian Loan) (Land Mapping and Registry) Act*. Citation.

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of any other enactment, the Government is authorized to borrow from the Government of Canada an amount of money not exceeding \$1 400 000 in the currency of Canada on such terms and conditions as may be agreed between the Government and the Government of Canada. Authorisation.

3. The money borrowed under the authority of this Act shall be appropriated and applied to finance expenditures to be incurred in the purchase of services, materials and equipment in connection with land mapping and the establishment of a land registration system. Purpose.

4. The payment of Charging.

- (a) the principal money borrowed under the authority of this Act;
- (b) any interest thereon; and
- (c) other charges or expenses connected therewith,

are a charge on the general revenue and assets of Barbados.
