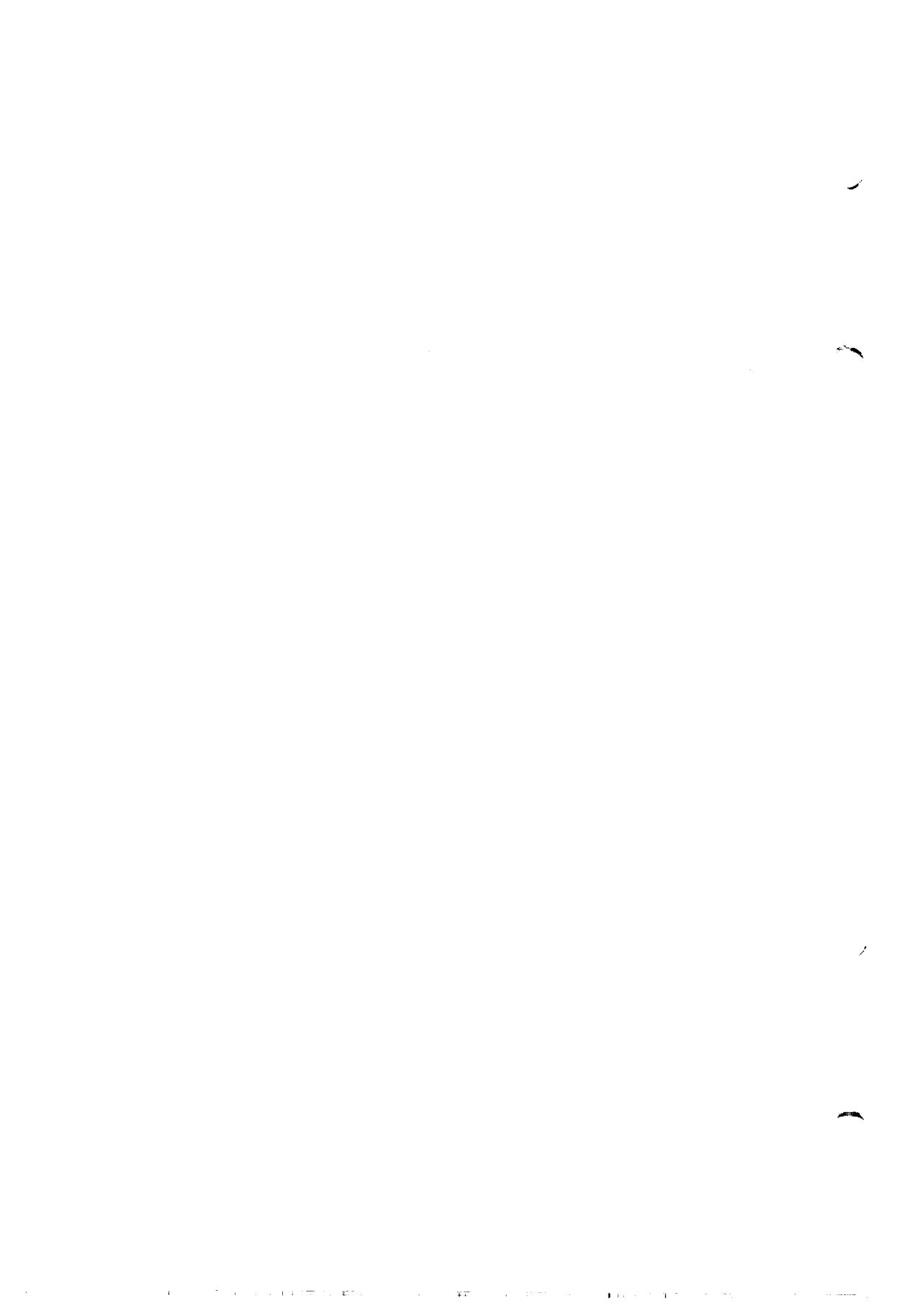

**CHAPTER 164**

**FIREWORKS**

*An Act to restrict the sale and use of fireworks.*

1966-31.  
1967-59.

[17th October, 1966] Commence-  
ment.

1. This Act may be cited as the Fireworks Act.

Short title.

2. No person shall on the fifth day of November in any year throw, fire or explode or cause or permit to be thrown, fired or exploded any squib, cracker, rocket, serpent or other firework whatsoever.

Prohibition

3. Any person who contravenes this Act shall be guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine of one hundred dollars.
