## CHAPTER 301

### PRINTERS AND PUBLISHERS

*An Act to provide for the printing of the names of printers on papers and books.* 1937-10.

[24th September, 1937] Commence-  
ment.

1. This Act may be cited as the Printers and Publishers Act. Short title.

2. Any person who prints any paper, pamphlet, tract or book whatsoever, which is meant to be published or dispersed, and who does not print upon the front of every such paper, pamphlet or tract, if the same is printed on one side only, or upon the first or last leaf of every paper, pamphlet, tract or book which consists of more than one leaf, in legible characters, his name and usual place of abode or business, shall for every copy of such paper, pamphlet, tract or book be liable on summary conviction to a fine of twenty-four dollars. Name and address of printer to be printed on papers and books intended for publication.

3. Any person who publishes or disperses or assists in publishing or dispersing any printed paper, pamphlet, tract or book on which the name and place of abode or business of the person printing the same is not printed in accordance with section 2 shall for every copy of such paper, pamphlet, tract or book be liable on summary conviction to a fine of twenty-four dollars. Penalty for publishing or distributing papers without printer's name.

4. Sections 2 and 3 shall not extend to the impression of any engraving or to the printing of the name or the name and address or business or profession of any person and the articles in which he deals, or to any papers, for the sales of estates or goods by auction or otherwise. Saving.
