## CHAPTER 294A

### ROAD ABANDONMENT

*An Act to provide for the abandonment of the rights of way and other rights of the public affecting a part of Enterprise Road, a public road in the parish of Christ Church, and for the dedication to the use of the public of an alternative road.* 1977-10.

[23rd May, 1977] Commence-  
ment.

1. This Act may be cited as the Road Abandonment Act. Short title.

2. As from the 18th April, 1974 all rights of way and other rights of the public affecting Enterprise Road in the parish of Christ Church from its junction with Highway 7 at Oistins in that parish for a distance of 810 feet shall be deemed to have been abandoned and to have ceased and determined. Abandon-  
ment of road.

3. As from the commencement of this Act the lands over which the new road is laid out at Keizer Hill in the parish of Christ Church between Highway U and Enterprise Road in that parish are dedicated for the use of the public as a roadway and sidewalk. Dedication to
