**CUSTOMS (WAREHOUSE RENT AND
CHARGES) NOTICE, 1970**

1970/155.

Authority: This Notice was given on 30th July, 1970 by the Minister under section 141 of the *Customs Act*.

Commencement: 6th August, 1970.

1. This Notice may be cited as the *Customs (Warehouse Rent and Charges) Notice, 1970*.

2. The Minister hereby directs that rent shall be payable as follows

- (a) on the items of goods specified in the *Schedule*, warehoused in a Government Warehouse for a period of 12 months or any shorter period, at the rate set out opposite thereto in the *Schedule*; Schedule.
- (b) on goods deposited in a Queen's Warehouse, at the rate of 4 cents per cubic foot or \$1.60 per ton for each 24-hour period or part thereof.

3. The Notice relating to the payment of rent and given under section 141 of the Act by the Governor-in-Executive Committee on 8th February, 1963 is hereby cancelled.

1. Cigars, Cigarillos, cigarettes	\$0.20 per pound
2. Tobacco manufactured, in tins	\$0.10 per pound
3. Tobacco manufactured, not in tins	\$1.25 per 100 pounds
4. Snuff, in cases	\$0.40 per cubic foot
5. Spirits in wood	\$3.60 per hogshead of 64 gallons
6. Spirit in bottles	\$0.50 per case of 1 dozen reputed quarts
7. Rum in wood	\$3.60 per hogshead of 64 gallons
8. Rum in bottles	\$0.50 per case of 1 dozen reputed quarts
9. Wine in wood	\$3.60 per hogshead of 64 gallons
10. Wine in bottle	\$0.50 per case of 1 dozen reputed quarts
11. Opium etc. in cases	\$0.40 per cubic foot
