**IMMIGRATION (PORTS OF ENTRY)  
REGULATIONS, 1976**

1976/25.

**Authority:** These regulations were made on 2nd February, 1976 by the Minister under section 31(1) of the *Immigration Act*.

**Commencement:** 2nd February, 1976.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the *Immigration (Ports of Entry) Regulations, 1976*.

2. The following places in Barbados are designated as ports of entry for the examination by immigration officers of persons seeking to enter or entering Barbados

- (a) the Port of Bridgetown comprising the Careenage, the landing place at the Baggage Warehouse and the Deep Water Harbour in the parish of Saint Michael; and
- (b) the airport situate at Seawell in the parish of Christ Church.
