**REPRESENTATION OF THE PEOPLE (IDENTIFICATION
CARDS REPLACEMENT FEE) REGULATIONS, 2007**

Authority: These Regulations were made on 12th March, 2007 by the Electoral and Boundaries Commission under the *Constitution* and section 68(1)(e) of the *Representation of the People Act*.

Commencement: 1st April, 2007

1. These Regulations may be cited as the *Representation of the People (Identification Cards Replacement Fee) Regulations, 2007*.

2. (1) Subject to paragraph (2), the fee payable for the replacement of a lost, defaced or destroyed identification card is \$25.00.

(2) Where a person whose identification card is reported lost, defaced or destroyed is 65 years of age or over, the fee payable under paragraph (1) shall be waived.
