**Authority:** This Notice was given on 13th March, 2000 by the Minister under section 107(1) of the *Road Traffic Act*.

**Commencement:** 23rd March, 2000.

**1.** This Notice may be cited as the *Road Traffic (Public Service Vehicles) (Parking Places) Notice, 2000*.

**2.** The places named in the first column of the *Schedule* together with the description set out opposite thereto in the second column of the *Schedule* are appointed as parking places for the parking of the classes of public service vehicles specified in the third column of the *Schedule*.

1. Constitution Terminal	The area of land bounded on the north by Crown lands and by lands of sundry owners, on the east by Crown lands on the south and on the west by Constitution Drive.	Minibuses and route taxis
2. Cheapside Terminal	The area of land bounded on the north by lands now or late of Robert O'Neal, on the east by Crown lands, on the south by Reef Road and on the west by Fontabelle Road.	Minibuses and route taxis
3. Speightstown Terminal	The area of land bounded on the north by Crown lands, on the east by the Speightstown By-pass Road, on the south by lands of sundry owners and on the west by lands of Saint Peter's Parish Church, Saint Peter's Girls' School and lands now or late of Majorie Philbert.	Omnibuses, minibuses and route taxis
4. Princess Alice Terminal	The area of land bounded on the north by Reef Road, on the east by Crown lands, on the south by the Princess Alice Highway and on the west by a public road.	Omnibuses, minibuses and route taxis
