**URBAN DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION
ORDER, 1997**

1997/131.

Authority: This Order was made on 25th September, 1997 by the Minister under section 5 of the *Urban Development Commission Act*.

Commencement: 8th January, 1998.

1. This Order may be cited as the *Urban Development Commission Order, 1997*.

2. The area of land described in the *Schedule* is designated as an urban area for the purposes of the Act. Schedule.

SCHEDULE

ALL THAT area of land situate in the parishes of St. James, St. Michael and Christ Church bounded by Paynes Bay Road and Holders Hill Road, St. James; Thorpes Road, Husbands Road to its intersection with Clermont Road; Clermont Road to its intersection with Highway 2A; the Errol Barrow Highway to its intersection with the Graeme Hall Road; Graeme Hall Road to its intersection with Maxwell Hill Road and Top Rock, Maxwell Hill Road, Cane Vale Road, Church Hill and Oistins Hill; Church Hill Road to its intersection with Thornbury Hill Road; Thornbury Hill Road to its intersection with Pegwell Gardens Road; Pegwell Gardens Road to its intersection with Pegwell Boggs Road; Pegwell Boggs Road to its intersection with Waverley Road; Waverley Road to its intersection with Keizer Hill Road; Keizer Hill Road to its intersection with Enterprise Drive, Enterprise Drive to a point on the coastline where the intersection of a line along Enterprise Drive Road meets the coastline; then in a westerly and northerly direction along the coastline to its intersection with a public drain at Paynes Bay in the parish of St. James which is bounded to the north by lands of Windward Investment Ltd., and to the south by lands of David Hinds Moore; to the north east by lands of the Crown, and Paynes Bay Road.
